


ALGAL SITUATION IN SWEDISH MARINE WATERS No 9, 25-27 May, 1998





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DETAILS

* POTENTIALLY HARMFUL SPECIES

Sampling in the Skagerrak and the Kattegat

SKAGERRAK

Stations HS5, M6, Å16 and P2, 26-27 May

High diversity, but small amounts of phytoplankton.

Among diatoms <u>Chaetoceros curvisetus</u> dominated, followed by <u>Leptocylindrus minimus</u>, <u>Guinardia flaccida</u>, <u>Pseudo-nitzschia pungens</u> and <u>Pseudo-nitzschia delicatissima</u>. The latter was very abundant at station P2.

Among dinoflagellates small species as <u>Scrippsiella</u> spp., cf. <u>Pentapharsodinium</u> sp. and <u>Heterocapsa triquetra</u> were common. Small amounts of <u>Ceratium</u> and <u>Dinophysis*</u> species were found in the central Skagerrak.. The PSP producing dinoflagellate <u>Alexandrium tamarense*</u> was observed in small numbers in the whole area.

Small amounts of the potential toxic genus <u>Chrysochromulina*</u> was observed, whereas the species cf. <u>Chattonella</u> sp.* which formed blooms earlier in May was not observed now.

KATTEGAT

Station Läsö Ränna, 25 May

High diversity with moderate amounts of phytoplankton.

Among diatoms <u>Chaetoceros curvisetus</u> dominated, followed by <u>Guinardia flaccida</u> and <u>Proboscia alata</u> and <u>Pseudo-nitzschia delicatissima</u>.

Dinoflagellates were dominated by <u>Ceratium longipes</u> and <u>C. tripos</u>. <u>Protoperidinium depressum</u> and small numbers of Dinophysis* species and Alexandrium tamarense* were also present.

Small amounts of the potential toxic genus <u>Chrysochromulina*</u> and the species cf. <u>Chattonella</u> sp.* which formed blooms earlier in May was observed in low numbers.

This report is based on net samples from the upper 20 m.

FORECAST

A beginning summer situation dominated by small flagellates and occasional blooms of diatoms can be expected the next few weeks.
